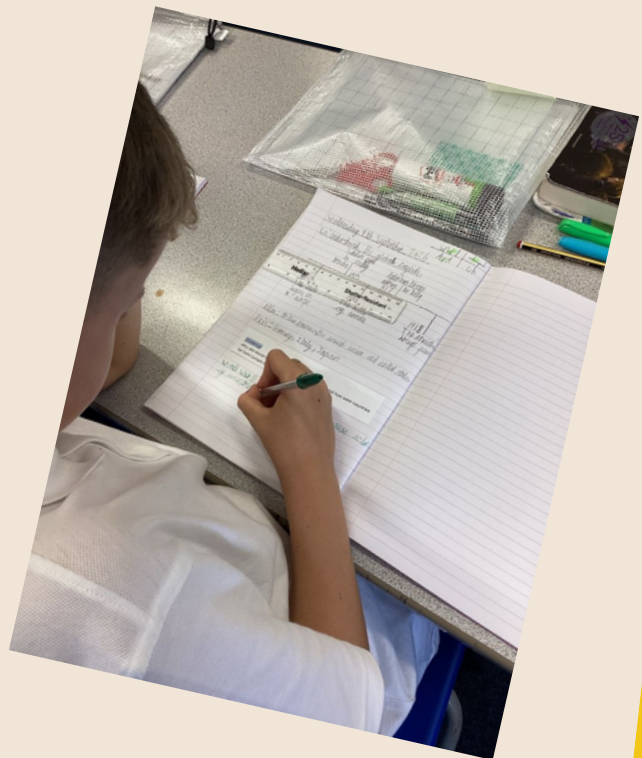
Year 4 and 5

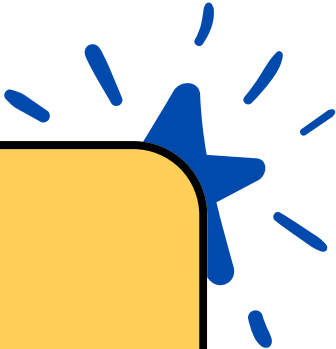
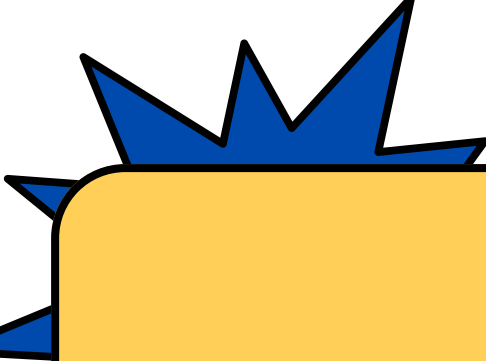
